Competition Rules and Regulations

- All dancing rules and regulations governed by S.O.B.H.D.
- Decisions of the Judges are final, including number of placements in any event.
- Classes will be divided according to number of entries received. Restricted classes only if entries warrant.
- Competitors dance only in their respective age groups.
- Competitors MUST be on hand when their event is called or forfeit entry in that event.
- Competitors must dance with swords and to music provided by the V.H.G.A.
- Dancers filling in for any Reel MUST DANCE ENTIRE DANCE which includes figure of eight movement and all setting steps.
- Competition Secretary must be notified of any class changes as early as possible.
- Protests must be made in writing and given to the Competition Secretary at the event, accompanied by \$5.00 fee. (refundable if sustained)
- All competitors **must be in full costume** and present registration cards to receive their medals.
- MARSHALS and COMPETITORS ONLY IN MARSHALING AREA.**
- NSF cheques** will be charged \$20.00.
- Entries must be postmarked no later than **February 8, 2008.**
